## **MWRA VALVE WORK MAY CAUSE DISCOLORED WATER IN MILTON**

On Tuesday, August 19, 2008, the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority's will begin replacing a water valve on Canton Avenue in Milton. This work may cause discolored water in the areas around Canton Avenue near Milton Town Hall and Highland Street near the police station over the course of that week.

If discolored water does occur, it will result from a small amount of iron in local pipes. While it is still safe for drinking, cooking and other uses, please note that iron *will* stain light colored items in your laundry, especially when bleach is used. Therefore, residents near this location should check water clarity before washing any white or lighter colored laundry during this period of work.
