As you are all aware at this time, many communities have begun updating their Emergency Procedure Plans in the light of September 11<sup>th</sup>, Hurricane Katrina, Tsunamis, possible Flu Pandemic and other incidents that could initiate a response from citizens. A Volunteer Medical Corps (VMC) is being formed in Milton in cooperation with Massachusetts Public Health Region 4b. Region 4b encompasses 27 communities in the metro-Boston area, with a population of approximately 981,000 residents. The Milton VMC will work to develop a cadre of trained volunteers and to coordinate the efforts of these medical, public health and other local emergency response volunteers to guarantee a timely and harmonized volunteer response for local and regional public health emergencies.
