Charge

- To study proposed capital projects and improvements involving major tangible assets and projects which have a useful life of at least five (5) years and cost over \$10,000.
- To consider the relative need, impact, timing and cost of anticipated projects requiring Town Meeting action during the ensuing five (5) years.
- To prepare an annual report recommending a capital Improvement Budget for the next fiscal year, and a Capital Improvement Program including recommended capital improvements for the following five (5) years. This report, as approved by the Board of Selectmen, is submitted to the Warrant Committee which makes its recommendations to Town Meeting for adoption by the Town.
