Houghton's Pond Resident Parking Program

May 15, 2019 - September 15, 2019

The Town of Milton will be implementing the summer resident parking program beginning May 15th 2019 for the streets surrounding the Houghton's Pond Recreational area. Current residents of Silverbrook, Eileen, and Adrian Road will be issued two permits per household to prominently display on their vehicles. Only vehicles registered to the aforementioned streets will be eligible for the program. The following information will be required when you register; name, address, telephone, registration plate number and email address. Permits will be mailed within 7-10 business days upon receipt of application. Please respond by **May 1st, 2019** by following the link below to register for the program. Town of Milton Parking Permits are issued at the discretion of the Chief of Police and the Town reserves the right to revoke permits at any time.
