

Household Hazardous Waste Collection

September 15, 2018, 9 AM – 12 noon

Where can I drop off my hazardous waste?

Milton DPW Yard, 629 Randolph Ave., Milton. Rain or shine. **Milton residents will be asked to show ID for proof of residency.**

Materials should be left in their original containers whenever possible. Containers should be placed in sturdy boxes and placed in the trunk of a vehicle so that contents will be easy to remove. **Residents will remain in their vehicles during the entire collection.**

What can I bring?

- ✓ Adhesives and glues
- ✓ Aerosol cans
- ✓ Engine degreaser, brake and transmission fluid, other automotive fluids (unmixed)
- ✓ Flammable liquids and aerosols
- ✓ Household cleaners and spot removers
- ✓ Oil-based paints
- ✓ Photo chemicals and chemistry sets
- ✓ Poisons, insecticides, pesticides, weed killers
- ✓ Solvents and varnishes
- ✓ Swimming pool chemicals
- ✓ Acids, bases, drain cleaners
- ✓ Waste fuels (kerosene, gasoline)
- ✓ Wood preservatives and fiberglass residue

You can also bring these items for an additional fee:

Please pay with Trash Stickers only. Cash and checks will not be accepted.

- Tires \$3.00 each
- Car batteries – up to 3 for \$3.00
- Waste oil, antifreeze – up to 3 gallons for \$3.00
- Propane tanks - \$3.00 each
- Fire extinguishers - \$3.00 each

What items will **NOT** be accepted? How can I dispose of these?

✗ Latex-based paints	<i>Let dry and dispose as trash. Check label.</i>
✗ Mercury-containing items including fluorescent bulbs	<i>Bring to Milton DPW Recycling Center during regular hours (first Saturday of each month, 9 AM – 12 noon).</i>
✗ Batteries	<i>Dispose alkaline batteries in regular trash. Bring other batteries to Recycling Center during regular hours.</i>
✗ Fuses or fuse guns	<i>Return to store or manufacturer.</i>
✗ Firearms, shells, and related equipment	<i>Return to store, manufacturer, Milton Police Department, or shooting range.</i>
✗ Flares	<i>Return to store or manufacturer.</i>
✗ Textiles and clothing	<i>Drop off in marked donation boxes in Milton public school parking lots.</i>
✗ Needles and syringes	<i>Dispose at Milton Board of Health.</i>
✗ Medication	<i>Dispose at Milton PD or a pharmacy.</i>
✗ Mattresses	<i>Call DPW to dispose curbside, or drop off at Recycling Center during regular hours.</i>
✗ Asbestos	<i>Hire a licensed asbestos removal company.</i>
